Applicant submits full legal description of the property to the City Planning Department City Engineering Department produces a 300' map based on the applicant submitted legal description City provides applicant the 300' map to give to an abstractor of their choosing Abstractor provides applicant the names/addresses of those property owners within the 300' map **Applicant Submits:** Completed and signed application If applicant is a company or something other than a personal owner, information showing who is able to sign a binding document for the company or group is required Planned Development Statement of Intent **Planned Development Drawing** \$325 fee Abstractor's Certificate with list of property owners within 300' Consent Statement, if necessary Planning Department posts property and advertises public hearing 10 days prior to hearing Preliminary Plan Public Hearing at Planning Commission Preliminary Plan at City Council (Not a public hearing) Final Plan at Planning Commission (Not a public hearing) City Clerk posts property and advertises public hearing 10 days prior to hearing
