Monday, March 20, 2017

On 3/17/17 at 11:59 P.M., a Norfolk Police officer performed a traffic stop on a vehicle in the 1200 block of South 13th Street for not having tail lights. The driver was identified as Cody R. Ausdemore, 26, of Norfolk. While having contact with Ausdemore, the officer smelled the odor of burning marijuana. In a subsequent search of the vehicle, officers recovered marijuana, a glass marijuana pipe, two scales, and several baggies containing a white crystalline substance. This substance later tested positive for methamphetamine. Ausdemore was arrested for possession of a controlled substance with intent to distribute, possession of marijuana less than 1 ounce, and possession of drug paraphernalia. He was housed in the Norfolk City Jail and later transferred to the Madison County Jail.

On 03/19/17 6:17 a.m., Norfolk Police officers were dispatched to 313 North 12th Street regarding a disturbance. While officers were responding, they were informed that a female was breaking out windows to a vehicle and standing on the roof of a car. When officers arrived they saw the damaged vehicle. It was located on the west side of the apartment complex. The vehicle's entire front windshield was damaged and a female could be seen inside the vehicle. At one point the female began to push on the windshield using her feet. As officers approached to make contact, the female exited the vehicle and attempted to flee from officers. The female was quickly taken into custody. The female was identified as Adri Acosta, 20, of Omaha. The vehicle had the front windshield damaged and back windshield broken out. The roof of the vehicle was partially dented. There were two large rocks also present on or in the vehicle which appeared to have blood stains on them. The owners of the vehicle were identified and Acosta was placed under arrest for criminal mischief. She was housed in the Norfolk City Jail and later transferred to the Madison County Jail.
