Water improvements on 3<sup>rd</sup> Street between Elm Avenue and Prospect Avenue will begin Monday



On Monday, June 12, water improvements will begin on 3<sup>rd</sup> Street between Elm Avenue and Prospect Avenue. These water improvements will replace an existing water line with a larger one in order to provide adequate fire protection for the Norfolk Public Library, which is undergoing an expansion, as well as area businesses.

Work on this project will begin at Elm Avenue. On Monday, Elm Avenue will be closed from 3<sup>rd</sup> Street to 4<sup>th</sup> Street to tie into the existing waterline. This closure is expected to last up to two weeks and during this

time, both intersections will remain open.

The City of Norfolk is asking citizens to drive cautiously in this area during the construction activity. Citizen cooperation is appreciated.
