CITY OF NORFOLK HOUSING DIVISION TO HOST THIRD NORTHEAST NEBRASKA FAIR HOUSING CONFERENCE

After a successful launch of the Fair Housing Conference in 2016, the City of Norfolk Housing Division is continuing their efforts to educate individuals about fair housing rights at the upcoming third Annual Fair Housing Conference. The approaching conference has been planned for Tuesday, April 10, 2018, from 9 am until 4 pm, at the Lifelong Learning Center in Norfolk. Registration and a continental breakfast will begin at 8:30 am.

This year, attendees will get to learn about fair housing, reasonable accommodations, applicant screening, as well as harassment and the Violence Against Women Act. Presenting the information is Sara McCue, an attorney at Baird Holm LLP in Omaha, Nebraska. Her practice focuses on the Fair Housing Act and the Americans with Disabilities Act. She represents and counsels housing providers, property management companies, education institutions, and the affordable housing industry. At the end of the conference, there will be an opportunity to ask questions that were gathered during the sessions.

Due to space limited to 150 registrants, those wishing to attend the conference should register early. If registered before March 30, 2018, the conference fee is \$50 or \$75 if registered after March 30. Current housing choice voucher landlords can register early for a fee of \$35 before March 30, 2018 or \$50 if registered after March 30. All registration fees include continental breakfast, lunch, and break. Differing from years prior, there will be no Continuing Education Units available for realtors or attorneys.
