MILL AND OVERLAY WORK TO BEGIN TUESDAY, OCTOBER 9

Though patch work for the mill and overlay project is already well underway, the mill and overlay portion of the project is expected to begin on Tuesday, October 9th.

Dustrol, the contractor for the project, plans to begin the milling process on Norfolk Avenue from 9th Street to 14th Street and will be working from the east to the west. An asphalt shop for the overlay function of the project is expected to be set up in the Norfolk area on Friday, October 5. After the milling process begins the overlay is expected to follow shortly after.

During this time, commuters can expect temporary lane closures and the repositioning of traffic control as the contractors work to complete the project. Contractors will be working under traffic during this time. This project is weather dependent and changes to the schedule may occur accordingly.

The mill and overlay project kicked off approximately \$1.5 million in street repairs and improvements earlier this fall. This work is improving approximately 13.5 lane miles of city streets.

“Better streets are a community-wide priority,” said Mayor Josh Moenning. “This series of projects reflects a first wave of major repair and reconstruction work on streets throughout the city.”
