“Kid’s Financial Program at the Library”



“Share, Spend and Save” is the theme of a financial program for kids that will be given by Bank of the West staff at the City of Norfolk Library September 27 and October 1 from 4:00 - 5:00 pm.

As part of the program, Bank of the West financial service representative Tiffany Kumm will present the library with two copies of the book “Three Cups” written by Mark St. German.

“The book is published by Bank of the West and written by a father who gives his son three cups for his birthday. Each cup represents how the son’s allowance should be divided into what should be saved, spent or shared,” Kumm said.

Kumm received training on the new program and will lead kids ages preschool through third grade in a 45 minute activity that includes going through the book, discussing financial concepts and distributing savings boxes that are divided into three compartments.

“Our goal is to encourage healthy finance choices, contribute to their self sufficiency, asset building and overall economic health in our communities,” Kumm said.

The program will be held in the meeting room of the Norfolk Public Library. Parents are encouraged to

attend with their children. There is no fee for the session.
