“Public Meeting to be held on Norfolk Avenue project”

Information about the reconstruction of Norfolk Avenue from 1st Street to Cottonwood Street will be given at a Public Open House on Monday, May 23, 2016 from 5:00 pm to 7:00 pm at the Norfolk City Council Chambers at 309 N. 5th Street (enter through the northwest door of the building.)

The project which is funded by the City of Norfolk includes roadway reconstruction, bridge replacement, trail construction and lighting improvements.

Stakeholders, business owners and members of the public are invited to the open house where exhibits of different phases will be shown. City of Norfolk staff and Olsson Associates project engineers will be present to discuss the project and answer questions.
