"City Administrator Shane Weidner inducted into Northeast College Alumni Hall of Success"



City of Norfolk Administrator Shane Weidner was recently inducted into the Northeast Community College Alumni Hall of Success.

According to the NECC director of development and award committee co-chair Holly Quinn, the award is presented to former students "who have achieved significant success in their profession, exhibited exemplary citizenship qualities, or made significant contributions to their community."

Weidner obtained Associate's Degrees in Chemistry, Biology and Criminal Justice from Northeast Community College in 1994-1997. He also obtained a Bachelor's Degree in Human Resources Management/Personnel Administration from Bellevue University and an Associate's Degree in Fire Protection from Southeast Community College. Prior to that, Weidner served as an infantryman in the Armed Forces.

Weidner was hired as a firefighter/paramedic for the City of Norfolk in 1990 and was eventually promoted to Fire Chief, a position he held for 15 years. In 2011 he was hired as the City Administrator in Norfolk where he currently oversees approximately 250 employees.

The Northeast Community College Foundation hosted the Achievement Awards Ceremony at the Lifelong Learning Center on Thursday evening.
