Those who want to participate can pick up a scavenger hunt form at the City of Norfolk Administration offices at 309 North 5<sup>th</sup> Street, the Norfolk Area Chamber of Commerce at 609 West Norfolk Avenue or Renegade at the Sunset

Participants solve the clues while visiting local businesses on November 26 from 9:00 am to 2:00 pm. They must receive a stamp from the business to receive credit for the answer. The completed sheet is then turned into the City offices, Chamber or Renegade or via email at [grow@ci.norfolk.ne.us](mailto:grow@ci.norfolk.ne.us) by November 28. If the entire form is completed it can be entered into a drawing to win \$800 in cash. If five or more of the clues are completed it can be entered to win \$200 in Chamber Cash Now certificates.
