“Governor Ricketts makes a stop in Norfolk”

Governor Pete Ricketts made a stop in Norfolk Thursday afternoon at the Norfolk Regional Airport to discuss the State of the State and to highlight his legislative priorities.

About 40 people were on hand to hear comments from the Governor on, among other things, state budget issues and reducing unnecessary regulations.

Mayor Josh Moenning thanked the Governor for promoting the expansion of Highway 275 from Scribner to West Point. City Administrator Shane Weidner asked that the decision of Amazon to pay sales tax in the state of Nebraska be requested of other online stores who do business in the state.

The governor is participating in a fly-around to many cities in the state including Grand Island, McCook, Lexington, Beatrice, Nebraska City and Kearney.
