“Water line work resumes on Madison Avenue”

On Thursday, March 23, 2017, construction on the Madison Avenue Water Line Replacement Project will resume with pavement removals near 7th Street and Madison Avenue in preparation for water line boring under the railroad tracks. Boring is planned to begin on Monday, March 27, 2017. Madison Avenue will be closed at times for this work.

Water line replacement will also begin at 4th Street and Madison Avenue on Monday, March 27, 2017. The 4th Street and Madison Avenue intersection will be closed at this time with the closure moving west as the work progresses.

All work on these projects is weather dependent and delays due to the weather are possible.

John Heine, City of Norfolk Engineer, advises people to use caution when traveling on Madison Avenue and through the nearby intersections and to be aware of increased alley traffic in the area.
