Norfolk Public Library project advancing as footings are placed



The footings are being laid and the structural steel is set to arrive the week of June 12th. The Norfolk Public Library renovation/expansion is advancing at a satisfactory rate and is expected to reach completion in the summer of 2018.

Phase I of this project began in April with the commencement of construction. During this phase, library materials near the construction zone were removed and a temporary wall was placed on the north side of the building. On May 31 concrete footings began to appear, and next week will bring

structural steel. It won't be long until the framing for the new addition can visibly be seen.

In the fall, phase II of construction will begin and the library will be closed to the public during the move from the original building into the new addition. Once the materials and services have moved to the new portion, patrons will be able to continue to utilize the library services in the new addition while construction continues in the original building.

During the summer of next year, citizens will be able to see and enjoy the completed project.
