Norfolk Public Library expansion and renovation continues to advance



Things are coming together for the Norfolk Public Library expansion and renovation project. Within the past month, the stem walls and footings for the expansion have been completed and the slab for the new addition has been poured.

Underground electrical and

plumbing lines for the new addition are being placed, and preparation for the new, west parking lot has begun. Structural steel for this project is being delivered and you will begin to see the framework coming together by the end of July.

This project began in April and is expected to be completed in the summer of next year. Individuals are invited to share their opinion on furnishings for the library. Several sample chairs are in the library for the public to try out and leave their comments.

Don't forget about the summer reading program! The construction hasn't stopped eager readers and learners from participating in the Build A Better World Program. Many completed reading records have been turned in by some of the 1,629 participants signed up.
