WARD 4 NORFOLK CITY COUNCIL SEAT

After notice of the resignation of Councilman Shane Clausen, a City Council seat for Ward 4 will be open for applications.

On Monday, February 5, 2018, the resignation of Councilman Clausen will be presented during the regular City Council meeting. Clausen will be leaving his post due to relocation to a different ward.

“I would like to thank the community of Norfolk and citizens of Ward 4, for giving me the honor and privilege to serve as a member of the City Council these last seven years,” said Clausen. “Norfolk has seen a lot of changes and growth during that time and over the past seven years my family has continued to grow along with it. Recently a home became available for us to fix up and sell. However, with much thought and discussion we have decided to move there to accommodate our growing family. This new home is not located in Ward 4, therefore I have submitted my resignation from the City Council. This was an extremely hard decision to make. I have always tried to be practical and do what’s best for the community of Norfolk when addressing the different issues that came before the City Council. I want to thank the individuals that voted for me and gave me the opportunity to serve Ward 4. I look forward to watching our community continue to grow and prosper. Thanks again Norfolk!!”

Citizens interested in applying for the seat must be a resident of Ward 4 (southeast quadrant of Norfolk), and submit a written statement of intention and personal resume to the City Administrator’s office no later than 4:30 pm on Monday, February 12, 2018. The Mayor and City Council may then proceed with interviewing applicants.

A special City Council meeting will be held Thursday, February 15, 2018, at 12:00 pm in the Council Chambers to fill the Ward 4 vacancy. The person chosen to fill the vacancy will remain in the seat until the term expires in December of this year.
