CITIZENS ASKED TO HELP LOCATE POTHOLES AS SPRING APPROACHES

There's always one telltale sign that signals the beginning of spring in many cities worldwide – potholes!

Potholes are commonly seen in the spring due to the expansion and contraction of ground water after it has entered into the ground under the roadway. When the water freezes, it expands – creating holes in the driving surface. Considering a wet and cold season is just about to end, many new holes will be popping up.

City of Norfolk Street Division crews are already hard at work locating and filling the holes.
