## NORFOLK SOLID WASTE DIVISION LENDS A HAND DURING SPRING CLEANING

The Norfolk Solid Waste Division is lending a hand to residents in an effort to make spring cleaning a little bit easier. From Saturday, April 14, until Saturday, April 28, the City will be providing a 2-week “Spring Clean-Up” period for residents to bring yard waste and old appliances for disposal. Some items may be disposed of for free, and some will require a fee, depending on the type of product. Listed below are acceptable appliances during the “Spring Clean-Up” period:

### Items for free disposal during Spring Clean-Up – Appliances:

- Refrigerator/Freezer
- Household air conditioners
- Dehumidifiers
- Stoves
- Ovens
- Clothes Washer
- Clothes Dryers
- Furnaces
- Microwaves
- Hot Water Heaters
- Trash Compactors
- Vending Machines
- Lawn mowers
- Bicycles

**\*Note; Empty all appliances of waste, NO food or clothes are allowed.**

### Items NOT accepted during Spring Clean-Up – Appliances:

- Radioactive
- Oil filters/paint cans/aerosol cans
- Compressed Cylinders and vessels. (Propane tanks, Fire Extinguishers, Refrigerants, Oxygen, Acetylene, argon etc.)
- Light Ballasts
- Transformers
- Anything that contains PCB or Mercury
- Anything that contains Asbestos

**Items with disposal fee during Spring Clean-Up – Appliances:**

- Appliance made of plastic (built-in dishwashers)
- Trash
- Tires
- TV/Computers

The yard waste disposal is available to non-commercial residents only. Grass, leaves, and garden debris need to be kept separate from woody material as they go in different areas. ALL debris needs to be removed from any container (bags/boxes etc.). Containers for bags will be provided at the disposal site. Listed below are acceptable yard waste items during this spring clean-up period:

**Items for free disposal during Spring Clean-Up – Yard Waste:**

- Grass/leaves/garden debris
- Brush/woody plants/branches/trees

**Items with disposal fee during Spring Clean-Up – Yard Waste:**

- Painted or treated wood, posts, railroad ties
- Any type of landscape rocks or cloth/plastic
- Bricks/concrete
- Trash
- Tires

The Norfolk Transfer Station’s normal hours are from 7:30 am until 5:00 pm Monday through Friday, and from 7:30 am until noon on Saturdays. Yard Waste area will be open additional hours during the Spring Clean-up; Saturday’s until 4:30 pm and Thursday evenings until 8:00 pm. It is located at 610 E. Monroe Avenue. During this “Spring Clean-Up”, residents are asked to bypass the weigh scale and follow the signs to the designated areas.
