MILL AND OVERLAY UPDATE – SEPTEMBER 17

Mill and overlay work on East Benjamin Avenue from Victory Road to the railroad tracks, and on First Street from Bluff Avenue to Northwestern Avenue began in the middle of last week.

Today, traffic control on East Benjamin Avenue was switched from the inside lanes to the outside lanes. Currently, the inside lanes in this area can be accessed, but the outside lanes will be closed off until further notice.

The inside lanes of First Street from Bluff Avenue to Northwestern Avenue are currently closed off and traffic is being diverted to the outside lanes. Tomorrow, the contractors anticipate switching the traffic control from the inside lanes to the outside lanes and drivers can use the inside lanes in this area.

Timeline of the project so far:

September 13: Work on the mill and overlay project began with the section of Benjamin Avenue from Victory Road west to the railroad tracks. Traffic control was set up directing cars to access the outside lanes.

September 14: Work on First Street from Bluff Avenue to Northwestern Avenue began with traffic being diverted to the outside lanes.

Other areas to be updated with this project:

Norfolk Avenue from 9th Street to 14th Street
McKinley Street from the Ta-Ha-Zouka Park sports complex to 5th Street
Fifth Street from McKinley Street to Jackson Avenue
