### City of Norfolk to Host Public Open House for One & Six Year Street Improvements Plan

An informal open house for the One and Six Year Street Improvements Plan will be held on Monday, December 10, from 5:30 pm to 7:00 pm at the Norfolk Public Library in meeting room A.

“The fact is we still have streets in conditions that are unacceptable for our expectations,” said Mayor Josh Moenning. “While we continue to make improvements throughout the community, we seek further citizen input to help craft the plans and timelines necessary to bring streets up to the higher standard citizens pay for and deserve from their City.”

This discussion will help public officials further identify citizen street priorities and create a way to implement them in the current One and Six Year Street Improvements Plan. The information that will be presented was collected from citizen input at the Public Works Open House which was held on October 30.

“Public participation is a beneficial step in the process of identifying and prioritizing infrastructure improvements for Norfolk,” said Public Works Director and City Engineer, Steven Rames. “Having this input assists us in prioritizing our limited resources.”
