Citizen's Vision Group Will Meet to Provide Ideas for Benjamin Avenue Improvement Project

A group of nine residents representing a variety of interests and points of view will meet beginning this Friday, April 5, to learn about the goals and challenges for making improvements to Benjamin Avenue.

More importantly the vision group will work with roadway design engineers and landscape experts retained by the City to help identify key features for the street improvement project over the coming months through a series of three additional meetings. Two public open house meetings are envisioned to be held later this year to gain even broader community review and comments on proposed improvements for Benjamin Avenue.

The vision group are men and women representing businesses, residential properties, schools who are connected with Benjamin Avenue, and the chamber of commerce. City public works officials will also attend the vision group meetings to provide information that may be requested by group members.

The meeting this Friday will be at the Norfolk Public Library in Meeting Room C, from 9 a.m. to 11 a.m. Other interested citizens of Norfolk are welcome to come to the meeting to observe the vision group and their deliberations.

News media representatives are fully encouraged to attend this, and all future vision group meetings to track the ideas and progress of this street improvement project.
