Modify Downtown Vehicle Parking District Parking Reorganization Plan/Policy
(customer/residential parking stalls)

Councilmember Rob Merrill moved, seconded by Councilmember Dave Fauss to approve a request from the Vehicle Parking District Board of Directors to modify the Downtown Vehicle Parking District Parking Reorganization Plan/Policy to designate some parking stalls as customer/residential.

Connie Geary, on behalf of the Vehicle Parking District (VPD), provided information to elected officials. The Downtown Vehicle Parking District Parking Reorganization Plan/Policy was approved by the City Council on May 20, 2013. Because of additional apartments in downtown Norfolk and, therefore, an increased demand for residential parking, the VPD is requesting to add the following extra residential spaces:

Lot E = +5 residential spaces
Lot F = +6 residential spaces
Lot B1 = +15 residential spaces
Lot D2 = + 4 residential spaces
Lot C1 = + 2 residential spaces
Lot C2 = + 2 residential spaces

Geary said residential signs will be placed below customer parking signs for the additional spaces.
