On 4/14/2017 at 2:56 A.M., a Norfolk Police officer conducted a traffic stop in the 1900 block of South 1<sup>st</sup> street on a vehicle that was driving without headlights. The female driver was identified as Karissa R. Dasher, 22, of Norfolk, and the male passenger was identified as Kevin N. Finkral, 46, homeless. A check of Dasher's license show that she had an active Platte County arrest warrant. Dasher was placed under arrest. Finkral was asked to step out of the vehicle during the traffic stop. When he did, a syringe fell from the vehicle when he opened the car door. When this occurred Finkral attempted to push the syringe away with his foot. Both Dasher and Finkral were questioned about this syringe and drug usage. In a subsequent search of Finkral, officers located another syringe which was located in his boot. Both syringes contained some type of liquid. In a search of the vehicle, officers located small baggie containing a white residue along with more unused syringes in a make-up bag. The residue in the bag and the liquid in the syringes tested positive for methamphetamine. Both Dasher and Finkral were arrested for possession of a controlled substance – methamphetamine. They were both housed in the Norfolk City Jail and later transferred to the Madison County Jail.
