On 05/22/19 at 7:43 a.m., Norfolk Police were dispatched to the 200 block of North 9th Street to check the welfare of a female a red Nissan that had been sitting there for several hours. Officers located the vehicle and had contact with the female driver who was identified as Haleigh D. Kappel, 24, of Lincoln (aka Haleigh D. Gerard.) A check of her identification showed two active Lancaster County warrants for her arrest. She was then taken into custody by the officers. In a subsequent search of the car, officers recovered two glass pipes containing white residue from the center console and a third pipe was located under the driver's seat. Also recovered was a multi-colored bong used for smoking marijuana. The glass pipes tested positive for methamphetamine. The charge of possession of a controlled substance was then added to her arrest. She was housed in the Norfolk City Jail and later transferred to the Madison County Jail.

On 05/22/19 at 3:27 p.m., Norfolk Police and Norfolk Rescue were called to the intersection of 4th Street and Norfolk Avenue for an injury accident. A southbound vehicle in the 100 block of North 4th Street was turning right (west) onto Norfolk Avenue, against a red light, and struck a pedestrian walking a bike eastbound in the crosswalk. The pedestrian identified as Marco Antonio Ventura Renteria, 24, of Norfolk. He sustained a non-life-threatening leg injury. He was treated at the scene and transported to Faith Regional Hospital by Norfolk Rescue. The driver of the vehicle was identified as Ashleigh L. Glinsmann, 28, of Norfolk. Glinsmann was cited for failure to yield right-of-way to a pedestrian.
