Robbery, 1st Degree Assault

On November 27th at approximately 6:05 p.m., Norfolk Police responded to a report of an assault in a parking lot just east of 116 Norfolk Avenue. Officers located an adult male victim who was bleeding heavily from his head and had teeth knocked out. It was also determined that his wallet was missing. The victim was transported to Faith Regional Health Services for treatment. The victim said he had just left a business at 116 Norfolk Avenue, when two male suspects approached him to start a fight. When he tried to leave in his vehicle, they blocked his exit. When the victim exited his vehicle to ask them to move, they attacked him with punches and kicked him while on the ground. The suspects then fled the scene. The victim did not know the suspects.

During the investigation, Norfolk Officers obtained descriptions of the suspects, and executed two search warrants where evidence was obtained.

The two suspects were identified as 25-year-old Angel Villalobos and 32-year-old Jose Tamayo, both of Norfolk. Villalobos was located and arrested for Robbery and 1st Degree Assault. Villalobos was booked into the Norfolk City Jail and later transported to the Madison County Jail. An arrest warrant has been issued for Tamayo with the same charges.
