Thursday, March 16, 2017

On 3/15/17, at about 8:59 p.m., it was reported to Norfolk Police that Taylor Pass, 25, of Norfolk, had been in possession of a firearm and that Pass was prohibited from possessing one due to felony convictions. An officer spoke to two witnesses who both confirmed that Pass had this firearm and where he had left it. The officer also confirmed that Pass was a firearm prohibited person. Based on these statements, officer went to the described location and recovered the firearm. At 12:05 a.m., the officer located Pass in the 800 block of S. 13th Street and placed him under arrest. In a subsequent search, officers located a plastic hollow pipe in his front pants pocket. The pipe had residue in it that tested positive for methamphetamine. Pass was taken to the Norfolk City Jail and questioned about the firearm and his drug usage. He was arrested for possession of a controlled substance – methamphetamine and possession of a deadly weapon by a prohibited person. He was housed in the Norfolk City Jail and later transferred to the Madison County Jail.

On 03/15/17 at 3:36 p.m., Norfolk Police responded to a disturbance at 112 W. Braasch Ave Apt #1. When they arrived they had contact with an adult female who claimed that Jose Ramos had assaulted her on 3/14/17 and again on 3/15/17. She related to officers that during the assault on the 14th, Ramos took a knife out of his pocket and placed it to her throat. Witnesses to the assault were also interviewed as well as Ramos. At the conclusion of the investigation, officers placed Jose Ramos, 26, of Norfolk, under arrest for 3rd degree domestic assault and terroristic threats. He was housed in the Norfolk City Jail and later transferred to the Madison County jail.
